Deep Water Cay, a private island resort off Grand Bahama Island, has served as the ultimate fly-fishing destination since 1958. The Cay stretches 2.5 miles and is surrounded by 250 square miles of bonefish and permit flats characterized by hard-packed sand, turtle grass, and mangrove shorelines. Recent record-setting catches, including a 15.4-pound bonefish and a 45-pound permit, bear witness to the Cay's meticulous conservation efforts. DWC also offers reef and offshore angling that takes sportsmen to the grouper, snapper, mahi, wahoo, and tuna that typically provide fresh nightly entrées at the Lodge.



There is a full dive program, too. In addition to scuba certification, dives and trips to the numerous formations and reefs, snorkeling is a popular activity, particularly in the Blue Holes, some a short swim from the beach. Kayak the mangroves, sail on the Hobie Cats, try the paddle boards, play tennis, swim in the infinity pool while you watch the sun set, or have a massage. The staff is incredibly friendly, and guides are among the best in the business. All have grown up fishing the area's flats and some are descended from the initial group of guides who began taking out anglers all the way back in 1958. Needless to

say, that kind of legacy is hard to find anywhere. The cuisine is superb—a blend of Bahamian, West Indian and Continental, based on fresh catches of the day. Guests who are fishing or just enjoying the natural environment receive picnic lunches pre-ordered the night prior. Cocktails and light appetizers are served at AJ's Tiki Bar located dockside. We also serve cocktails and hors d'oeuvres at the main lodge bar 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm nightly. Land in Freeport 30 minutes from Ft. Lauderdale and Miami by commercial airlines or a private landing strip and with customs clearance right on the Cay. Deep Water Cay is small and secluded, open to the public with reservations, and there are limited homeownership opportunities available in case you never want to leave.
